1. When you think of God's holiness, what ideas or images come to mind?
2. Read 2 Samuel 6. What words would you use to describe the mood of those bringing the ark to Jerusalem (2 Samuel 6:1-5)?
3. Why do you think David and the people of Israel viewed this as an occasion to celebrate with all their might (2 Samuel 6:5)?
4. Uzzah's act of taking hold of the ark seems well intentioned (2 Samuel 6:6). Why then did the Lord's anger burn against him (2 Samuel 6:7; see also 1 Chron. 15:11-15)?
5. Why are sincerity and good intentions sometimes not enough to please the Lord?
6. After Uzzah died, David became both angry and afraid of the Lord (2 Samuel 6:8-9). How would you evaluate his emotional response?

7. Although the Lord had struck down Uzzah, he blessed the house of Obed-Edom (2 Samuel 6:10-11). What was the Lord saying about himself through these events?
8. What new precautions does David take as he moves the ark to Jerusalem (2 Samuel 6:12-15)?
9. In what other ways was this event marked by celebration?
10. Do your times of worship tend to be somber or joyous? Explain.
11. In what ways might we make our times of worship more of a joyous celebration?
12. How does this chapter help us to understand God's holiness?
